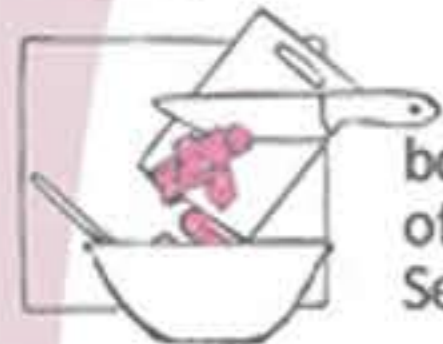
How to make a 9 day batch of prepared cat food for the average adult cat:



1. Into a bowl, weigh 20 g (3 level Tbsp) Tcfeline SPECIAL FORMULA premix.



2. Add 250 ml (1 cup) cold water. Adjust up or down for desired food consistency. Whisk thoroughly.



3. Add 900 g (2 lbs) raw, boneless, lean ground meat of your choice. Combine. See User Guide for all options.



4. Divide into portions and freeze food for storage. Small, silicone muffin cups work great!

Yields 18 x 65g (1/4 cup) portions.

TIPS: Measure all ingredients by weight for best results. When using Tcfeline Special Formula, addition of liver is not required to complete the food nutritionally. Liver can be added to a batch at a rate of 50 g fresh or 20 g freeze-dried for palatability, if necessary. The food can also be prepared with cooked meat. See User Guide for details. Defrost food in microwave just before feeding. Refrigerate uneaten portions immediately. Discard thawed leftovers after 24 hrs.

Ingredients: *Whey Protein Isolate, Calcium Carbonate, dehydrated Antarctic Krill, Taurine, L-Carnitine, Feline Future B Complex (Choline L-Bitartrate, Niacin, D-Calcium Pantothenate, Methylcobalamin, Thiamine Mononitrate, Pyridoxine HCl, Riboflavin, Folic Acid, D-Biotin), Iron Bisglycinate, Vitamin A Palmitate, D-Alpha Tocopheryl Succinate (Vitamin E), Vitamin D3, Potassium Iodide.*

Reseal pouch after use. Store premix in a cool, dry place. Use by:

Tcfeline Special Formula is a supplement premix designed to simplify the preparation of nutritionally balanced raw cat food at home. It produces a diet that is lower in phosphorus and overall ash content, making it ideal for cats 12 years and older, as well as cats with Chronic Kidney Disease. Tcfeline Special Formula allows cat lovers to combine a tested nutrient base with their own choice of fresh, boneless, lean meat. This premix serves as a practical continuation of raw feeding when cats' dietary needs change with age. Chronic Kidney Disease is a common, slow, progressive condition in older cats, with no single cause other than ageing itself. One of the best defences is to feed a high-moisture diet and to reduce dietary phosphorus at the appropriate stage of a cat's life. Additional supplements are not necessary or advised, except under the direction of a veterinarian. See User Guide for analysis and more information.

This is a complete diet for adult maintenance; however, it should not be fed to kittens or to pregnant or lactating queens, as the prepared diet does not sufficiently meet the calcium and phosphorus requirements for growth and reproduction.

Feeding Guidelines:

For the average adult cat, feed 65 g (1/4 cup) of prepared cat food twice daily. Adjust amount and frequency as needed. Older cats and cats with Chronic Kidney Disease benefit from smaller portions fed more frequently.
